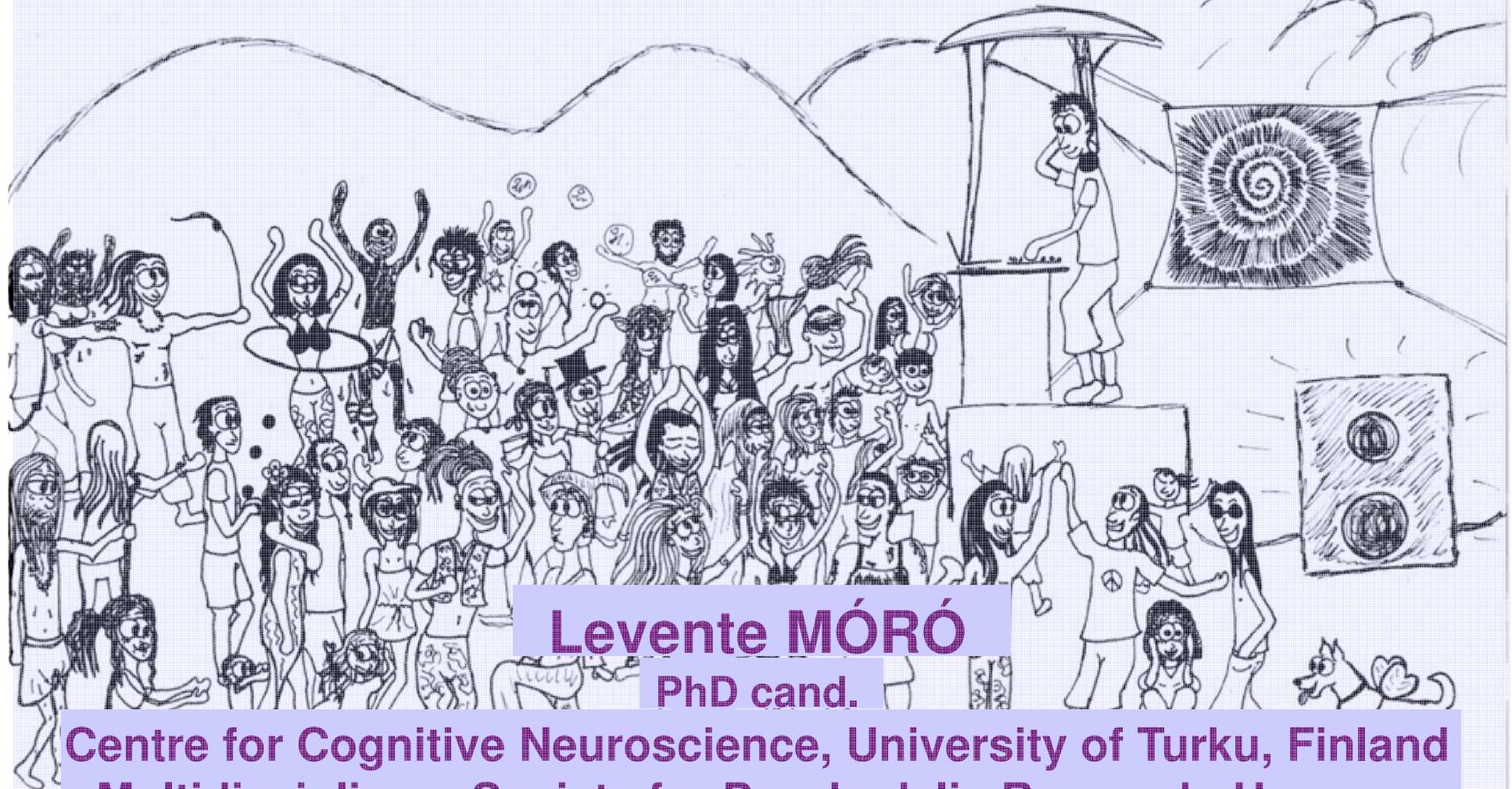

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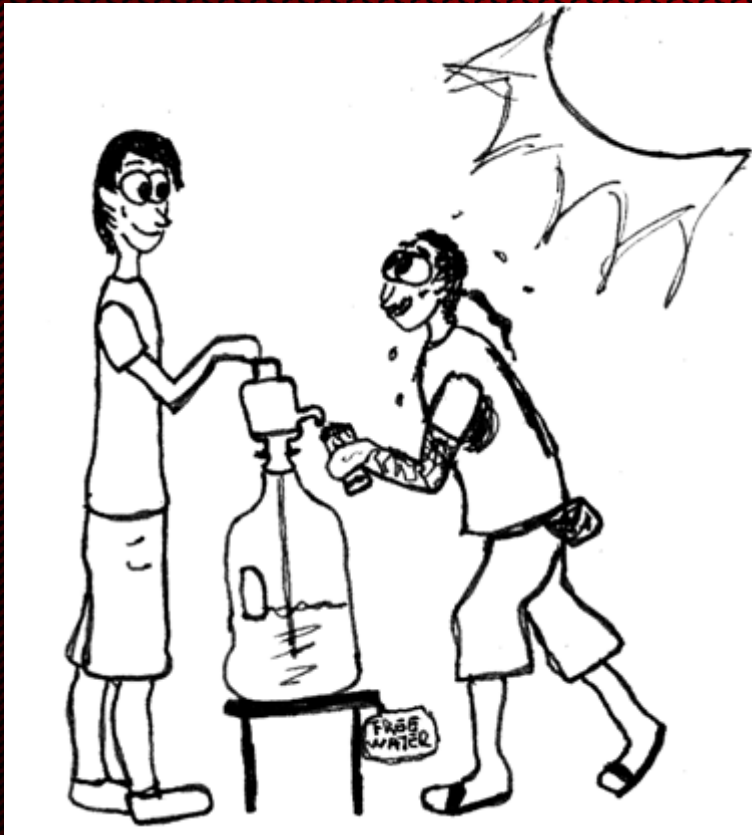


Contemporary psychedelic subculture

- *electronic dance music events*
- *Goa, Psytrance, Chillout etc.*
- *manifold higher prevalence of hallucinogenic drug use among visitors of these events*
- *hallucinogens, such as LSD, DMT, psilocybin, and mescaline*
- *„set” & „setting” ideal for drug use*
- *life-enriching experiences in a supportive environment*
- *substantial risks associated with the ingestion of psychoactives*



Harm reduction at parties and festivals



Increased safety risks:

- *isolated location*
- *harsh environmental condition*
- *outdoor phenomena*
- *psychoactive substance use*

-> harm reduction interventions!

Help services:

- *distributing drinking water*
- *substance information*
- *first aid*
- *psychological help*
- *analyzing drugs*

Risks of psychoactive drug use



Impurities, dosing errors, misidentifications, drug interactions, pre-existing medical conditions, and/or a reckless attitude toward substance use

...may cause physical and/or mental discomfort

...with serious health consequences or accidents

Types of emergencies

- **Medical**
threat the integrity of the biological body as a system
- **Psychological**
difficult processing of emotional content and life problems
- **Psychiatric**
pre-existing disorders or drug-triggered acute psychosis
- **Psychedelic** ('bad trip')
hallucinatory & delusional perceptions of world / body / mind
- **Spiritual** ('crisis')
religious-mystical pondering of life / universe / existence

Psychedelic consciousness alteration

- *mainly serotonergic hallucinogens*
- *temporary alteration: destabilization -> repatterning*
- *"looping" or incoherent thought processes*
- *impaired short and long term memory*
- *hallucinations and delusions may appear as real*
- *attention may turn inwards or toward unreal things*
- *repressed emotions or traumatic memories may surface*
- *diminished rational and verbal levels of interaction*

What is the client like?



- *anxiety and fear*
- *difficult to access verbally*
- *may not tolerate proximity*
- *unpredictable behaviour*
- *no ethical norms and social roles*
- *paranoia, catatonia, stupor*
- *disorientation*

Client case examples

naked people sitting, walking, running, etc.

"timeless" long trips

crashing after long usage

friends lost

epileptic seizures

reckless dosage

psychiatric patients

energetic, caught by security

spiritual crises

DOx / NBOMe instead of LSD

freeloaders

Helping in psychedelic emergencies

- *cases can be managed with somewhat similar methods*
- *metabolic activity decreases drug effects gradually by time*
- *the helping process requires active care for a few hours*
- *convince to stay at the helping premises*
- *prevent accidental injuries*
- *disadvise from taking more drugs*
- *calming presence and occasional communication*
- *no abstractions, no questions, no negative associations*
- *simple verbal instructions*
- *repeated reassurance: the trip will surely end*

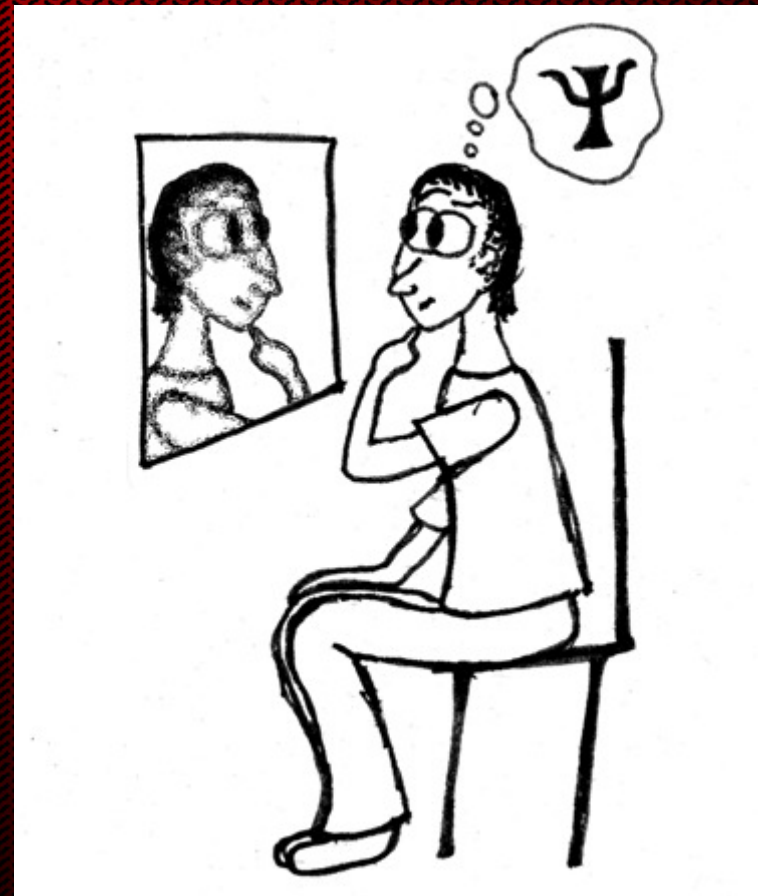
Special requirements for helpers

- *Knowledge of first aid and handling emergency situations*
- *Knowledge of psychoactive substances*
- *Knowledge of altered mental states*
- *Psychological suitability*
- *Teamwork suitability*
- *Clientwork suitability*

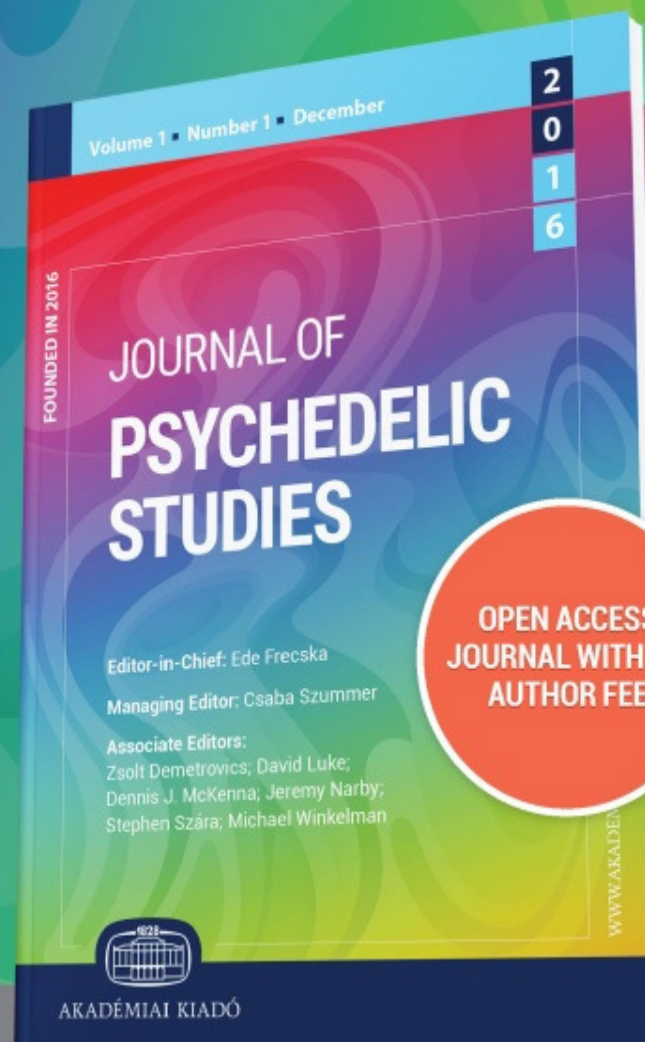
